This stereotyping about the Adivasi community leads to their discrimination and marginalisation.

Que6)How were Adivasis marginalised?

Ans-Adivasis feel marginalised due to their poor and low social status. This sense of difference and exclusion leads to communities not having access to resources and opportunities, and in their inability to assert their rights.
