Initiation: race, worm, wind, nobody.

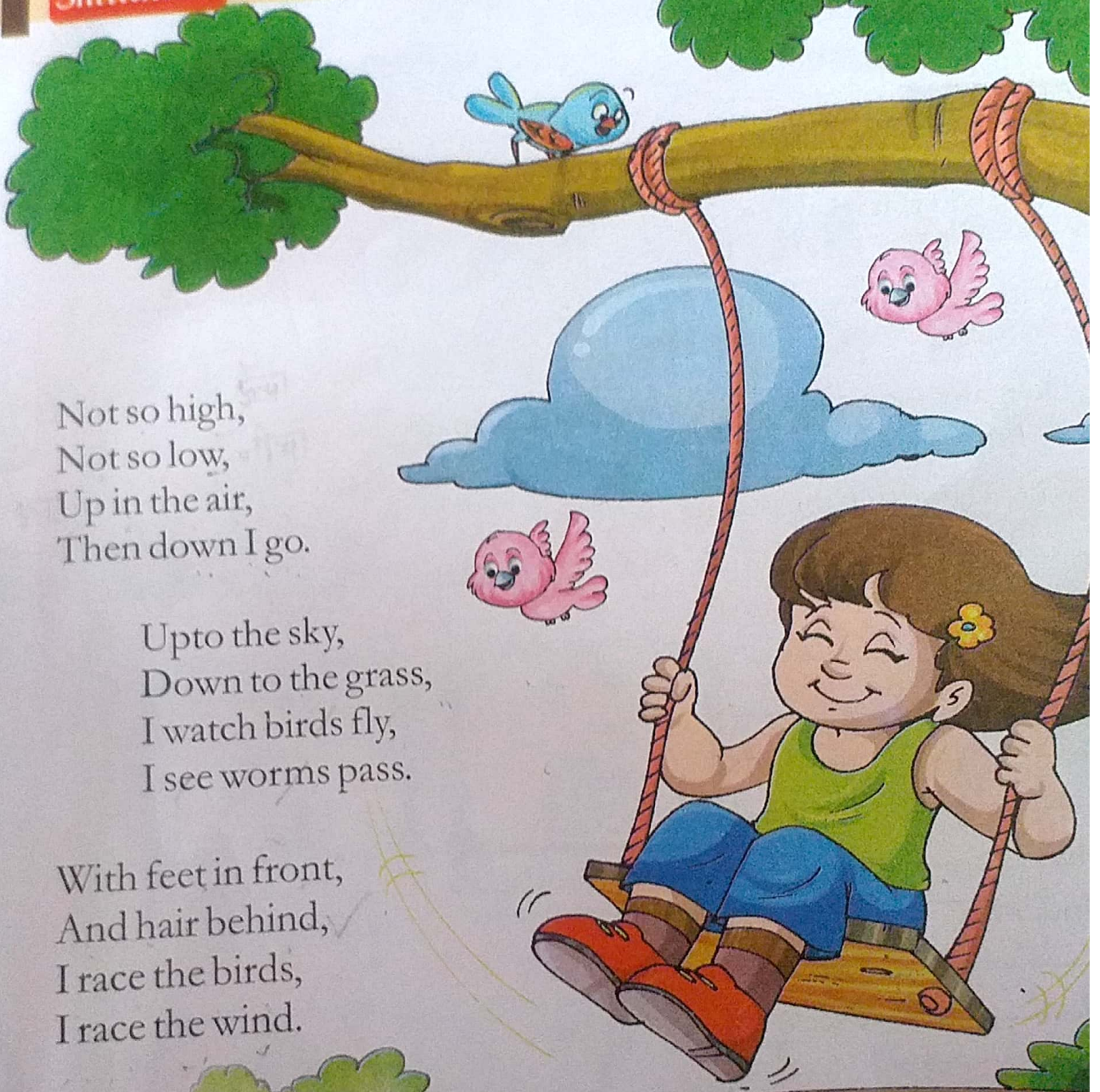
Not so high,

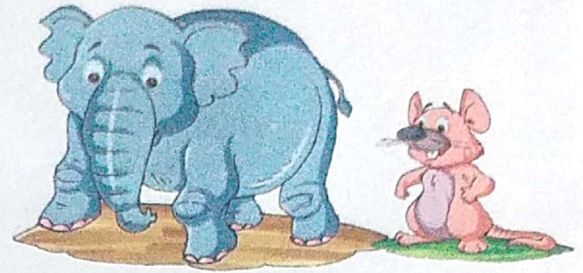

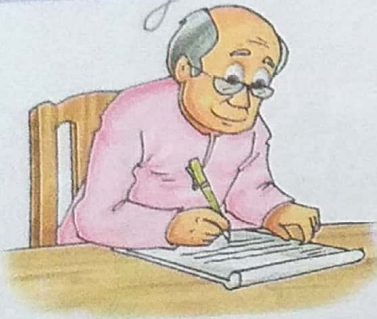
