

Numbers from One to Nine








In Abacus, first strand from right is called one's strand, second strand from right is called ten's strand and third strand from right is called hundred's strand.

Every strand contains maximum upto nine circles. So, at one's strand, its value is equal to the number of circles. To represent zero on Abacus, we do not put any circle.




