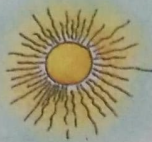

Uniforms

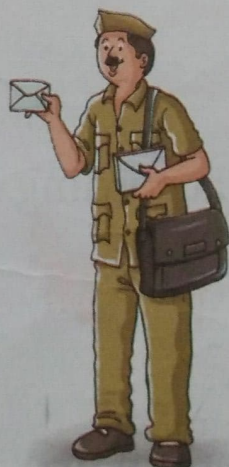


Here is Priti. She is wearing her **school uniform**.
