Read the given groups of words, as:



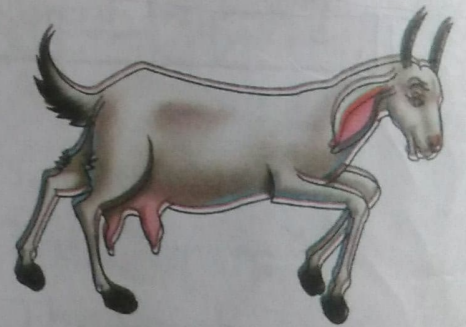
1. Raj and friends Varun are.
